ELIGIBILITY

All entrants must have a 2017-2018 USBC membership card or receipt. Non-members may qualify by purchasing memberships for \$20.00 or by paying a participation fee of \$5.00. All entrants MUST have bowled an actual 600 series in an USBC-sanctioned league or tournament. All entrants must be a member of the MN State and a local MN USBC Association.

AVERAGES

Highest Standard or Adjusted Sport league Average shall be used in this tournament. All entrants will use their highest 2016-2017 averages, based on a minimum of 21 games. Bowlers not having an established 2016-2017 winter average must use their highest 2017 spring/summer average. Please be advised, composite averages will not be used for this tournament. Bowlers with no previous season average shall use their current average (12 games or more) as of the first date of bowling (October 7th). Please bring verification of average at the time of bowling. All others will bowl scratch (210). Bowlers are responsible for verifying their own average, whether submitted by the bowler or others. If the submitted average is lower and results in more handicap, the bowler's score is disqualified. If submitted average is higher, prize winnings will be based on the submitted average. Average corrections can be made up to the end of the first game of a series.

RULE 319a (2), 319c, 319d, 319e will NOT be in effect.

HANDICAP/SCRATCH

Handicap will be 90% of 210 with no limit.

PARTICIPATION

Each bowler may bowl each event once. To participate in the all events, the bowler must also bowl the singles and doubles events.

BRACKETS

Handicapped brackets will be conducted each shift. If there are enough entrants interested in participating in scratch brackets, they will be available each shift. Proceeds used for awards and to offset expenses.

FORFEITURES

Bowlers failing to appear at the scheduled time will forfeit all money unless they can be rescheduled. Bowlers arriving late will receive 0 for all frames missed. Forfeiture of entry fees and prizes will follow disclosure of any violation of USBC tournament rules. If canceling a reservation, please do so 24 hours before the scheduled shift time.
