

RULES & REGULATIONS

- 1. All entrants must be USBC certified in youth division leagues in Minnesota. Bowlers should be able to present their current membership card if asked.
- 2. Coaches must send average sheets dated March 1, 2017 when sending in forms. If average sheets are not received, bowler(s) will bowl scratch until average verification is received for tournament. Brackets will be available at the cost of \$5 each. With no verification of average before you bowl scratch will be used and will not change bracket scores once verified. Verification must be postmarked within 7 days from the date you bowled for individual score and team excluding brackets. Bracket scores will not be adjusted. All events will be offered in both HANDICAP & SCRATCH at \$5 for each event. All event scores will be used with the 1st entry of each event.
- 3. USBC rule 400 regarding membership eligibility does apply.
- 4. Team consists of four (4) bowlers, any combination of boys or girls. There are four divisions based on averages for the team event. See entry for breakdown.
- 5. Handicaps will be figured using 90% of the difference between the team average of 840, doubles 90% of the difference of team average of 420, singles 90% of 210.
- 6. Bowlers must use highest current certified USBC average (including traveling league) of 21 games as of March 1, 2017. If you don't have an average of 21 games or more must use your highest current average of 12 games or more as of March 1, 2017. If no average of 12 games or more the bowler will bowl scratch (210).
- 7. Teams: a bowler may participate up to three times in the team event. Team roster must have a change of two players in order to have multiple entries. USBC Rule 322b applies to absentee scores. (Walk-ins welcome if space available) Bowlers bowling team will be automatically entered into the Gert Finke, Dawn Crowson & Jamie Tischer scholarships.
- 8. The coach or team captain is required to check in 45 minutes prior to their scheduled shift times. Bowlers not present at scheduled time will be permitted to bowl starting in the frame being bowled. Failure to appear for scheduled time and unable to be rescheduled forfeits the reservation and entry fee. The tournament director reserves the right to declare an emergency. Bowlers may require to bowl singles and doubles at the same shift time. Indicate on your entry form.
- 9. Entry fee is \$80 per team. To guarantee your reservation entry forms and fees must be received/postmarked by April 1, 2017. After that date, entries will be received on a first come first serve basis according to availability. No refunds will be given. Entry fee breakdown: \$38 lineage, \$34 prize fund and \$8 expenses. Make checks payable to MN State USBC. A \$25 fee for any returned check. Team Event scholarship monies will be based on a ratio of 1:4 per division (1/4 of the arship amount per actual bowlers. Plaques for all first place division winners. An award given to a minimum ratio of 1:15 per division.
- 10. Events: Doubles or Singles. Scholarship monies will be based on a ratio of 1:4 per division. Plaques will be awarded to first place and medals based on a 1:15 per division. Doubles (\$40): \$19 lineage, \$17 prize fund and \$4 expenses. Singles (\$20): \$9.50 lineage, \$8.50 prize fund and \$2 expenses. Doubles can consist of any gender combination— the combined averages of the doubles participates will determine their division. A bowler may bowl either singles or doubles. Bowlers may bowl only once in singles. Bowler can bowl multiple doubles with a limit of 3 entries with different partners.
- 11. Pins will be awarded for honor scores bowling a 200, 225, 250 game and 50 pins over average. (depending on averages)
- 12. All Scholarships are deposited in MN State USBC Association SMART Program #8699
- 13. Proper attire must be worn. No tank tops, halter tops, abbreviated shirts, revealing attire and hats or caps. Tournament director will make final decisions on all attire.
- 14. All rules not covered will be covered by the USBC Playing Rules. There will also be no open bowling or practice on day of tournament.
- 15. In the capacity of team captain, I hereby enter the above named team in the events indicated in the USBC Tournament described above and all agree to abide by the tournament rules. Provide your email address and we will email your entry confirmation. Captains may also be an adult coach or coordinators filling out form.
 - Gert Finke Scholarship: will be awarded to one girl and one boy in each division for an actual High Game and actual High Series. High Series takes precedents over High Game and the bowler qualifies for only one award.
 - Dawn Crowson Scholarship: will be awarded to one girl and one boy in each division for high game and high series based on individual handicap. High Series takes precedents over High Game and the bowler qualifies for only one award.
 - Jamie Tischer Scholarship: will be awarded one boy and one girl in each division who bowls the most pins over their average for a series.

Note: To be eligible for the Gert Finke, Dawn Crowson or Jamie Tischer scholarship the bowler MUST bowl Team Event
